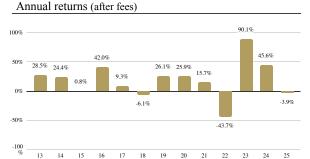

PERFORMANCE (as of March 31, 2025)





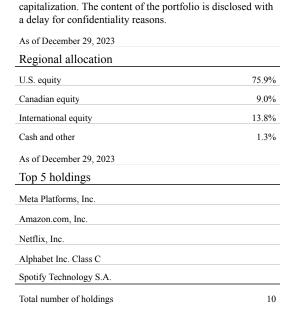
Growth of a \$100,000 investment since inception
