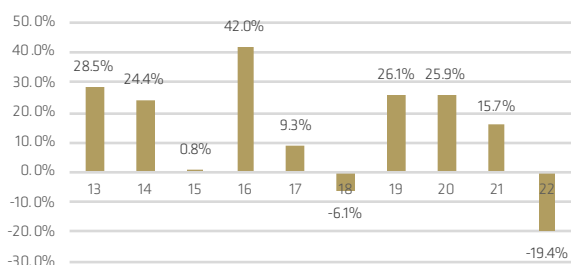

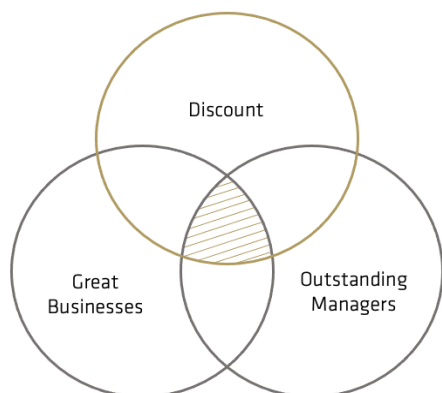

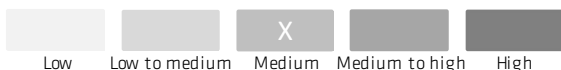
### Annual returns (after fees)

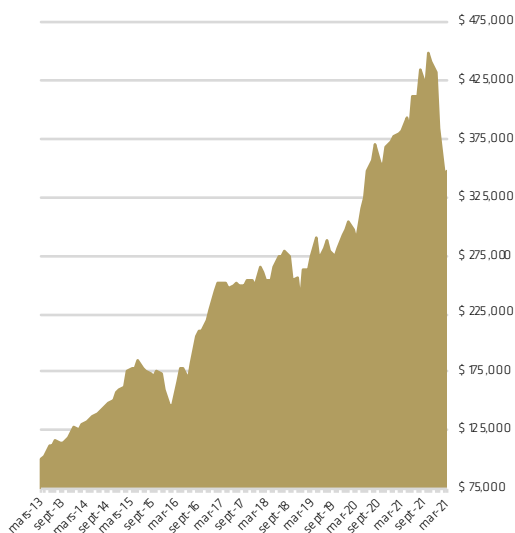
